NO SINGING VAMPIRES NO JULIA ROBERTS JUST GREAT THEATER

In a town where anything goes to get attention, the up-and-coming theater company Theater Forum has hit on a radical recipe for success: powerful writing, sensitive direction, impeccable acting. Theater Forum's production of Lanford Wilson's Tony-nominated drama *Angels Fall* opened April 21 with little fanfare, but critics and audiences alike are stunned and delighted by the quality of this compelling show.
